STATEMENT OF THE STUDENT COUNCIL:

All connected with the College have every reason to be humiliated and chagrined at the gross discourtesy that was shown by President Robinson, Dean Gottchall and members of the Administration to the Student Council and the Student Body.

Professor Costa had agreed to allow the Student Council, the representative of the student body, to participate in the welcome to the Italian students. The Student Council intended to welcome the delegation with anti-fascist greetings since the administration's reception condoned the fascist regime.

However, certain groups with the college administration and the Fascist students seized the occasion to support fascism and even attempted to assault the student council speaker. Fortunately, the student body was able to prevent this last indignity. The disposition of the whole matter will undoubtedly rest with the entire student body, because disciplinary action will assume the role of fascist terror against the student body. Fascism must be defeated!
