

IN UNITY THERE IS STRENGTH!

Yesterday the American Student Union was attacked as an organization ruled by a Communist-Socialist machine.

That "rule" has included activity for such "Red" issues as the American Youth Act, the defense of democracy in Spain, continuation and extension of the National Youth Administration, free books and lower prices on Chem kits, a real cooperative store, a better lunchroom, against the ROTC, for the extension of social activities.

The program of the Progressive Student Party is practically identical with that of the S.U. With the same programs to choose between, the real issue must be defined so that an intelligent choice may be made.

Will the student body guarantee us a strong, unified student movement through supporting and building the A.S.U., or will it allow a handful of dissenters, who have raised confusing issues, to disrupt the intensive work which lies before us?

WE STAND COMMITTED TO THIS PROGRAM:

1. FOR ACADEMIC FREEDOM: a legal A.S.U., passage of the McGoldrick resolution.
2. ECONOMIC SECURITY: free text-books, lower prices on Chem kits, better and cleaner lunchroom, continuation and extension of the N.Y.A., passage of the American Youth Act.
3. AGAINST WAR AND MILITARISM; for the abolition of the R.O.T.C.-- as a step towards this, the granting of partial credit for completed courses.
4. FOR THE ANNUAL STUDENT STRIKE AGAINST WAR.
5. AGAINST FASCISM: against the McNaboe investigation.
6. FOR THE REMOVAL OF PRESIDENT ROBINSON.
7. AGAINST NEGRO DISCRIMINATION.
8. FOR BROADENING OF THE STUDENT COUNCIL: direct representation from all clubs; for House Plan affiliation with the S.C.
9. STUDENT CONTROL OF FRESHMAN CHAPEL: one chapel a week.
10. BIGGER AND BETTER SOCIAL ACTIVITIES AT THE COLLEGE.
