PROGRAM OF THE YOUNG COMMUNIST LEAGUE

The Young Communist League Fights:

For social and unemployed insurance at the expense of the bosses and government, regardless of age or former employment. Not one cent for militarism -- all war funds to the unemployed. Against all forms of forced labor.

For the 6-hour day for young workers under 18 and the 7-hour day for those over that age with no reduction in weekly pay.

Against the speed-up and piece work system. For 2 -- 15 minute rest periods daily.

For a 4 week vacation with pay for all youth under 18.

For the right of all young people to vote at the age of 18.

For full economic, social and political equality for the Negro people, For the right of self-determination in the Black Belt of the South.
