


## Note to Mr. Riza

## DRAFT LETTER TO STATES NOT PARTIES TO AMENDED PROTOCOL II TO THE CCW

I am pleased to attach, for your approval and for the Secretary-General's signature, a draft letter to States not Parties to Amended Protocol II, inviting them to consider consenting to be bound by the above-mentioned Amended Protocol.

You may wish to note that last year the Secretary-General sent a similar appeal to States, pursuant to a recommendation of the Fourth Annual Conference of the States Parties to Amended Protocol II held in December 2002.

Excellency,

The Fifth Annual Conference of the States Parties to Amended Protocol II on Prohibitions or Restrictions on the Use of Mines, Booby-Traps and Other Devices, held on 26 November 2003, recommended that I, as Depositary of that Protocol, on behalf of the States Parties, exercise my authority to promote the universality of Amended Protocol II.

In my capacity as Depositary of Amended Protocol II, I invite your country to consent to be bound by the Amended Protocol. As you are aware, landmines, and especially anti-personnel mines, continue to take the lives of innocent civilians, to maim men, women and children indiscriminately, to aggravate the disastrous economic consequences of armed conflicts, and to threaten future generations. The global elimination of the threat posed by anti-personnel landmines should thus remain a priority goal of the international community.

The adherence of your country would represent a significant contribution to the strengthening of international law aimed at prohibiting and restricting the use of such inhumane weapons.

Please accept, Excellency, the assurances of my highest consideration.
