

Dear Mr. President,



## Report by the High Representative for Implementation of the Peace Agreement to the Secretary-General of the United Nations

## 01 November 1999

## **END OF JUNE -MIDDLE OF OCTOBER 1999**

Pursuant to Security Council Resolution 1031 of 15 December 1995, which requested the Secretary General to submit reports from the High Representative in accordance with Annex 10 of the Peace Agreement and the Conclusions of the London Peace Implementation Conference of 8-9 December 1995, I herewith present the fifteenth report to the Council.

The Report covers the activities of the Office of the High Representative and developments in Bosnia and Herzegovina during the period from the beginning of the end of June to the middle of October 1999.
