Note to the Secretary-General

Unforeseen and Extraordinary Expenses

I wish to inform you that I have authorized your signature on a memorandum to the Controller approving the use of funds relating to the appointment of Ian Martin as your Personal Representative for Support to the Peace Process.

Another request is currently in the pipeline relating to the costs of Mr. Martin's team, which includes political officers, military advisers, electoral personnel and a security expert. Since the latter request was less clear in terms of what could appropriately be funded from the Unforeseen and Extraordinary Expenses, I had asked DPA to consult further with the Controller's office. I understand that a revised estimate – lower than the original request – has now been submitted with regard to Ian Martin's team.

I wanted to flag that we most probably will be getting another request in the near future, jointly from UNHCHR and DPKO, to fund the DRC human rights mapping exercise from the unforeseen and extraordinary expenses.

In this connection, I thought it might be of interest to you to see what you have authorized so far in 2006 from these funds (see attached list).

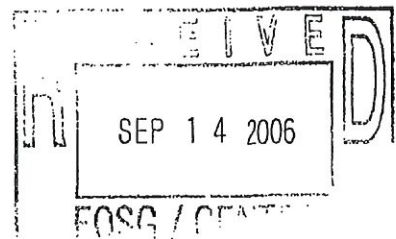
