MONUC: Draft revised concept of operations

Where

- 1. A DPKO team has recently returned from the DRC, wher it was working with MONUC on the revised concept of operations called for by resolution 1332 (2000).
- 2. The draft concept now proposed by MONUC, on the basis of the team's input, calls for a reduced military presence of up to about 3,000 personnel. Up to 1,900 of these would be formed units, whose purpose would be to guard equipment and facilities against theft and vandalism. The mission would still be essentially an observer operation, whose purpose would be to monitor and verify the implementation by the parties of the disengagement of forces plan adopted on 6 December. The revised concept is based on our experience within the DRC over the past 15 months or so of our deployment. We believe it is feasible, and probably less costly than the existing concept of operations (5,537 personnel).
- 3. We would like to brief you on the revised plan, perhaps early next week at your convenience. With your approval, the revised concept would then be included in your forthcoming report to the Security Council, which should appear about 12 February.

4. We await your instructions.
