Please find below, for your approval, suggested topics for the Security Council Luncheon of 13 July. The list was prepared by DPA following consultations with DPKO.

1. **AU summit in Sirte, Libya:** Major issues discussed and outcome of the summit.
2. **Côte d'Ivoire:** Outcome of the 28-29 June Pretoria meeting and status of the peace process.
3. **Middle East Peace Process:** 23 June Quartet meeting in London and expected withdrawal of Israeli forces from Gaza.
4. **Ethiopia/Eritrea:** Tension along the border due to "accidental" events (e.g. 3 shooting incidents have taken place relating to cattle stealing).

* **Zimbabwe?**

Other possible topics pending developments

5. **Burundi** (In the event the 4th July legislative elections create a crisis).
6. **Timor Leste:** Serious crimes process in Timor-Leste and Commission of Experts appointed by the Secretary-General (in the event the Council has not considered the Commission's report by then).
7. **Uzbekistan/Kyrgyzstan** (Provided DPA receives a copy of the report of the recent OHCHR mission to Kyrgyzstan -- to interview witnesses to the violence in Andijan, Uzbekistan-- and further developments on this issue closer to the date of the luncheon).
8. **Guinea Bissau** (In the event that the security situation deteriorates before the second round of the presidential elections).
9. **Sudan:** Update on the Abuja talks on the conflict in Darfur and the issue of ICC prosecution.
