Dear Mr. President,

I have the honour to refer to the United Nations Peacekeeping Force and my mission of good offices in Cyprus.

Until 1992, the Secretary-General's Special Representative for Cyprus was resident on the island. Subsequently, it was decided to appoint a non-resident Special Representative for Cyprus who was to deal specifically with matters relating to the good offices mission of the Secretary-General, and a resident Deputy Special Representative who also acted as Chief of the United Nations Operation in Cyprus.

Under this arrangement, since July 1998, Ms. Ann Hercus has been serving as resident Deputy Special Representative and Chief of the United Nations Operation in Cyprus. From April 1997, Mr. Diego Cordovez served as one of my Special Advisers with the specific task of helping me to promote and facilitate a comprehensive settlement of the Cyprus problem. On 22 April, I agreed to Mr. Cordovez's request to relieve him of his responsibilities with regard to Cyprus.


Since assuming my functions in 1997, I have been considering the advantages in the longer term, including continuity and greater familiarity with events in Cyprus, of reverting to the previous practice of having a Special Representative of the Secretary-General resident on the island. In this connection, following the usual consultations, I wish to inform the Security Council of my intention to appoint Ms. Ann Hercus as my resident Special Representative and Chief of the United Nations Operation in Cyprus with effect from 1 July 1999. Her appointment will help my mission of good offices and assist me in the event of comprehensive negotiations with the parties.

I also wish to place on record my warm appreciation for the important contribution Mr. Cordovez has made in the search for a comprehensive settlement of the Cyprus problem. I am glad to say that he will continue to be available to me as a Special Adviser, primarily on issues relating to Latin America.

I should be grateful if you would bring this matter to the attention of the members of the Security Council.
