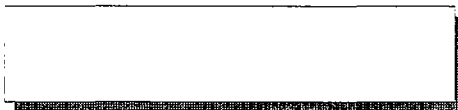

Dear Mr. Secretary-General,

I equally felt our meeting was useful and has paved the way forward for the preparations of the Millennium Summit. Also, may I thank you for your prompt action on designating Messrs. Moncef Khane and John Ruggie to join my team to produce a draft outcome document.

Others on the team are my Facilitators, Ambassadors Gert Rosenthal (Guatemala) and Michael J. Powles (New Zealand), and two officers from my Office. From time to time, I will request an Acting President to represent me, in my absence.

They have started some brainstorming and will share their initial thoughts with me in the course of next week, bearing in mind the Special Session which starts next week.

Prior to my departure for China, I held consultations with the Chairpersons of the Regional Groups on the same matter of the Millennium Summit preparations, and the outcome document. While there were several suggestions on when the draft document should be made available to delegations, we agreed to keep them, for now, abreast of the envisaged timetable through the ongoing intergovernmental consultative process.

I, therefore, intend to do so soon after the Special Session in New York. That notwithstanding, I will arrange for us to meet early next week, in consultations with your Office, for a mutually convenient day and time.
