

NOTE TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL



Subject:

Security Council Briefing on the Humanitarian Situation in Afghanistan

- 1. Today I joined Mr. Goulding and briefed the Security Council on the humanitarian situation in Afghanistan in light of the recent intensification of conflict and main conclusions of the International Forum on Assistance to Afghanistan. Please see attached a copy of my remarks.
- 2. During the subsequent discussion, members of the Security Council indicated great interest in the humanitarian situation in Afghanistan and appreciated the continuing assistance activities of the United Nations. They were of the view that convening of the Forum was an important and timely initiative. Support was also expressed to the UN effort to develop and implement a comprehensive strategy which would address immediate relief as well as longer-term rehabilitation and development needs in a broader context of peacemaking and peace-building efforts.
- 3. Many delegations encouraged the Secretariat to conduct this type of briefings on various aspects of UN operations. Members of the Council seem to like your new measure by which heads of responsible departments participate in its informal deliberations.
- 4. The Permanent Representative of Guinea-Bissau suggested that we consider organising similar conferences for other countries, particularly "fragmented states" confronted with a crisis of governance. He encouraged the Secretariat to explore the possibility of applying an integrated approach to assistance to Somalia.
