

NOTE TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

DURBAN CONFERENCE

- 1. You inquired yesterday about the origin and purpose of the arrangements in Durban for a joint meeting with the four Heads of State involved in the New African Initiative (South Africa, Nigeria, Algeria and Senegal).
- 2. Following our query, Mrs. Robinson's Office confirmed that she suggested the joint meeting, with a view to coordinating matters on the question of reparations and slavery which is being proposed for inclusion in the agenda of the World Conference. The African Group in Geneva apparently mandated members of the new African Initiative to handle the question at the Conference. It was in this context that Mrs. Robinson suggested the joint meeting. We have tentatively scheduled the meeting for Friday, 31 August 2001 (first day of the Conference) at 11:30 a.m., following the closure of the opening ceremonies. The arrangement will remain on your schedule, unless you instruct otherwise.
