# REMARKS AT THE SCREENING OF EN ROUTE TO BAGHDAD New York, 8 June 2005


Ms. Duarte, Dear colleagues,

- ➤ People in many countries, on almost every continent, remember Sergio Vieira de Mello as someone who was there to help them in their hour of greatest need.
- > For us in the United Nations, Sergio's work epitomized everything our Organization stands for.
- ➤ He dealt willingly with the most daunting challenges. He undertook the most uncomfortable assignments. He tackled the toughest missions.
- ➤ He had the diplomatic skill, insight, compassion and commitment to make local communities true partners in the work of the United Nations on the ground.
- > There has probably never been a time in world affairs when the international community was in greater need of Sergio's qualities, character and courage than it is today.
- > In the outpouring of tributes since Sergio's death, people may risk losing sight of the fact that Sergio was first and foremost a human being.

- > It is a legacy of light, which will inspire humanitarians, peacekeepers, peacemakers, and peacebuilders for generations to come.
