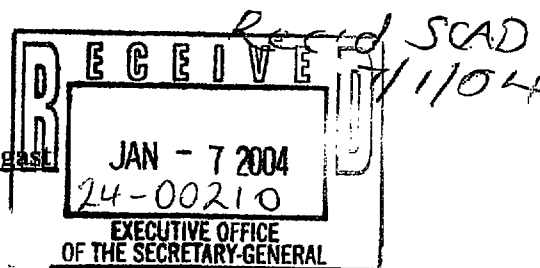

Note to Mr. Kieran Prendergast



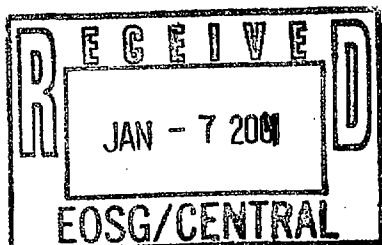
This is with reference to your note to the Secretary-General of 5 January 2004 concerning Brazil's intention to accredit an Argentine national to its delegation to the Security Council in the year 2004. Given that your note does not refer to my meeting on 23 December 2003 with the Deputy Permanent Representative of Brazil and the Permanent Representative of Argentina on this matter, I would be very grateful if you would further apprise the Secretary-General of the substance of that meeting (copy of my note to the file, which was copied to you on the same day, is attached herewith for ease of reference). Basically, it is important for the Secretary-General to know that notwithstanding the political significance of the arrangement, legally speaking, the composition of a Member State's delegation to any organ of the United Nations is the sovereign prerogative of each Member State. Under international law, there is no prohibition on the inclusion of non-nationals in the representation of a sending State. As such, there is no need to make an issue of the matter.
