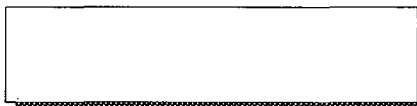

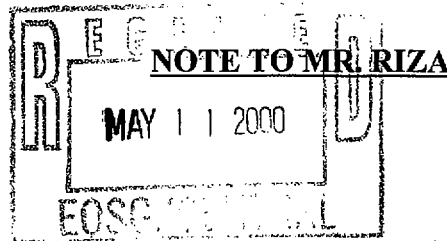



The Ambassador of Ghana has just informed me of the following important decisions taken at yesterday's Abuja summit by the assembled West African leaders, (but not explicitly set out in precise terms in the Final Communique):

- The sub-region was willing to provide the three additional battalions for UNAMSIL – if the requisite international (financial) support was forthcoming;
- The mandate given by the Security Council for UNAMSIL would have to be changed from peacekeeping to peace enforcement;
- In view of the urgency of the situation, the sub-regional countries were willing to act immediately.

The Ambassador of Ghana stated that these points were communicated to him by Mr. Victor Gbeho, the Ghanaian Foreign Minister.
