

1. It is estimated that an amount of \$85,000 would be required to charter an aircraft for the departure of dependants from New Delhi to Bangkok, following the current situation between India and Pakistan.

- 2. As no appropriation has been made for this unforeseen requirement, I hereby authorize you to enter into the necessary additional commitments up to a maximum of \$85,000 under the authority granted to me in paragraph 1(a) of General Assembly resolution 56/256 relating to unforeseen and extraordinary expenses.
- 3. I certify that these expenses relate to the security of United Nations personnel.

1. On your authority, Designated Officials in Pakistan and in India have been instructed to move to Phase 3 of the security plan. As such, arrangements are currently in progress to expedite the departure of their dependents from New Delhi. Dependents in Pakistan have already departed via commercial aircraft.

- 2. There are approximately 214 dependents in India. A Singapore Airlines aircraft has been chartered to transport dependants from New Delhi to Bangkok on Wednesday, 5 June. The requirements for this operation are estimated at \$85,000.
- 3. Accordingly, I am attaching for your signature a memorandum by which you would authorize commitments up to a maximum of \$85,000 under the authority granted to you in accordance with paragraph 1(a) of General Assembly resolution 56/256 on unforeseen and extraordinary expenses for the biennium 2002-2003.
