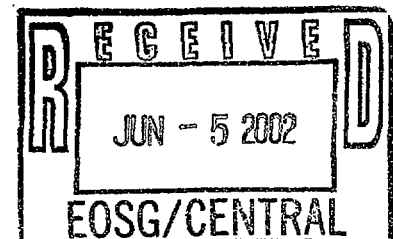


SUBJECT: **Unforeseen and extraordinary expenses: Transportation of**

1. It is estimated that an amount of \$85,000 would be required to charter an aircraft for the departure of dependants from New Delhi to Bangkok, following the current situation between India and Pakistan.

2. As no appropriation has been made for this unforeseen requirement, I hereby authorize you to enter into the necessary additional commitments up to a maximum of **\$85,000** under the authority granted to me in paragraph 1(a) of General Assembly resolution 56/256 relating to unforeseen and extraordinary expenses.

3. I certify that these expenses relate to the security of United Nations personnel.



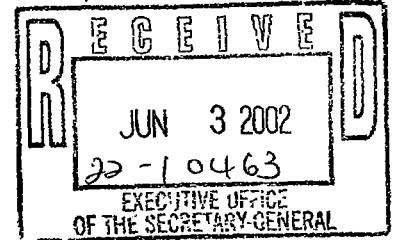

1. On your authority, Designated Officials in Pakistan and in India have been instructed to move to Phase 3 of the security plan. As such, arrangements are currently in progress to expedite the departure of their dependents from New Delhi. Dependents in Pakistan have already departed via commercial aircraft.

2. There are approximately 214 dependents in India. A Singapore Airlines aircraft has been chartered to transport dependants from New Delhi to Bangkok on Wednesday, 5 June. The requirements for this operation are estimated at **\$85,000**.

Accordingly, I am attaching for your signature a memorandum by which you would authorize commitments up to a maximum of **\$85,000** under the authority granted to you in accordance with paragraph 1(a) of General Assembly resolution 56/256 on unforeseen and extraordinary expenses for the biennium 2002-2003.
