Dear Mr. Secretary-General,

The Security Council remains gravely concerned about developments in the Occupied Territories and the region.

Recalling its Presidential statement of 13 July 1998 (S/PRST/1998/21), the Security Council continues to be determined to keep developments under review, and to provide the needed backing to the Middle East peace process, giving full support to the Agreements achieved as well as to the timely implementation of those Agreements.

The Council calls upon the concerned parties to pursue the negotiations and to fulfil their obligations under the Agreements achieved, so that progress can be made towards a just, lasting and comprehensive peace based on Security Council resolutions 242 (1967) and 338 (1973).

Please accept, Mr. Secretary-General, the assurances of my highest consideration.
