It is my pleasure to forward to the Secretary General the enclosed Sign to Save Lives petitions, compiled by one of Professor Elie Wiesel's students, Ms. Corissa Krueger.

Last Fall, Corissa enrolled in Professor Wiesel's Fall 2004 course *Literature of Memory III: Literary Responses to Oppression*. The crisis in Sudan was naturally a topic of class discussion. Professor Wiesel's goal, and hope, was to convey the "eleventh" commandment, "Do not stand idly by." Corissa more than rose to the challenge: she designed and circulated a petition which appealed for intervention on behalf of the Sudanese people. SIGN TO SAVE LIVES IN DARFUR

To the President of the United States of America:

We, the academic community of Boston, are signing on behalf of the millions who continue to suffer daily due to the humanitarian crisis in Darfur. These victims are being slaughtered, raped, and tortured by marauding militias and the ruling regime. Their homes and villages are burned and destroyed, forcing hundreds of thousands into unsafe and unsanitary refugee camps. These acts of genocide will not cease unless met by force from the international community. However, no decisive actions have yet been employed. And our own government, while well aware of the severity and malicious nature of this crisis still stands idly by. Every day that we stall intervention, more are dying from these unceasing horrors as well as from the starvation and disease that plague the refugee's camps. We will no longer remain silent or indifferent about these issues.

We the undersigned demand that our government, as a potent, influential, and resource rich member of the global community:

- > Take immediate action and responsibility to directly intervene in Darfur
- > Employ decisive force to disarm and disband oppressive militias as well as their patron the Sudanese government.
- > Bolster humanitarian aid efforts
- > And work to secure the safety of those who continue to fear for their lives and health.
