We're blocking Monday evening 2 May for the screening of the National Film Board of Canada peacekeeping production. This looks pretty safe at this point but the programme is always subject to change.

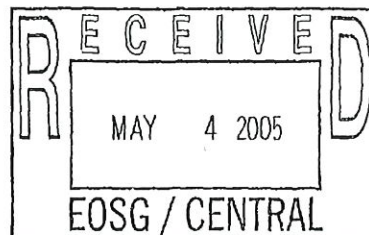
Incidentally, I had an e-mail today from Jonathan Rich, who I understand has been hired to set up the screening. Very good guy. I'm sure he'll deliver.

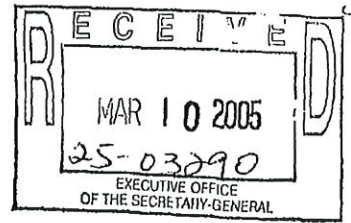

Request for your attendance at the premiere of "The Peacekeepers"

stuff at your meeting/video conference with media leaders on 12 April. Since that meeting is about HIV/AIDS I do not think this would be appropriate.

1. The Canadian Film Board is requesting your attendance at the New York premiere of their film "The Peacekeepers." They have suggested either the first or second week of May as possible dates.

2. As you recall, in 2003 a film crew from the Canadian Film Board was granted permission to film inside the UN, primarily at internal DPKO meetings. Their filming coincided with the crisis in Bunia, DRC, and their film soon became focused on DPKO's efforts to address the developing situation.

3. The resulting product presents an unvarnished but generally positive perspective on both the work of DPKO and of the UN system in general. A draft copy of a publicity flyer is attached for your reference. Given the shortage of good news regarding UN peacekeeping lately, especially with regards to the DRC, it is our recommendation that you agree to this request, subject to the demands of your schedule.

But DPKO are v. keen for you to attend the NY premiere as explained in this note from JMG, and I think that is probably OK if you can find the time.
