RE: Briefings to the Transition Team

As you already know, the thematic briefings for the transition team are slated for next week. In the context of your own briefing to Ambassador Kim Won-soo on UN Reform on Monday, I would like to point out that it would be important to do justice separately to the issue of Management Reform.

Undoubtedly, the team will be hearing from various parts of the UN system on the issue. I hope you will agree with me that ultimately the most accurate picture would best be conveyed by the focal point who has been dealing with the issue from the very beginning, namely, Adrian Hills. I sincerely believe that it would certainly be in our best interest to include him in the briefing.

As the team has indicated that they would like to combine the briefing on the Coherence Panel with a short briefing on the functions of the DSG's office, I have already suggested to them that Adrian and/or Mark Suzman (I leave it for MMB to decide) should join Paolo Galli when he briefs them next week. However, it may also be worth mentioning to Ambassador Kim on Monday that a stand alone briefing on the Management Reform has considerable merit.
